- Staffing Updates:
 - Welcome David Solnicki, currently covering Ms. Lafranier's Gr6 Gifted class
 - Welcome Khushbu Masrani, currently covering Ms. Gamliel's Gr7 Gifted class
- Adam reviewed the staffing model options and decisions for 2022/23, based on current enrollment projections
- COVID procedures:
 - Administration is continuing to send daily case reports to all families
 - Rapid test kits are still available, can be picked up from the office
 - Short-term virtual learning has ended. If you would like to switch to virtual, please contact administration to discuss your options
- Virtual Talent Show: The deadline for submissions has been extended until May 18th.
 Submissions can be made using FlipGrid and all approved submissions will be shown in classes.
- Ms. Lim-Wong (Gr 7/8 Virtual) collected names of Gr7/8 students who would like to participate in the Waterloo Math Gauss contest which will be held virtually on May 18th. Mr. Cabacungan is also offering this program to his Gr.5 Gifted class.
- April 28th is Holocaust Remembrance Day. Gr6-8 students will be invited to attend a
 special presentation by a grandparent of Forest Hill students who was a child of the
